Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 7th November 2016 at 7.00pm

16/082 Minutes of previous meeting 3rd October 2016 These were approved and signed.

16/083 Matters arising - request for ditch to be dug out (outside Sanstone). Councillor Dennis informed that this had been completed (not sure by whom possibly by Cormac). Cllr. J Dennis and Cllr.P Hawke will try to keep it, and the corner vegetation cleared to ensure water flows into ditch rather than across road

16/084 Declarations of interest None declared

16/085 Public Participation - 1. More concerns expressed re speeding mainly at various points in Ladycross / Yeolmbridge.

Another fairly major accident at Bude road/ Church Lane (Mr J. Stanburys barn seriously damaged). Clerk asked to write to Police again reiterating Council and Parishioner concern.

2. Concern expressed about the light having disappeared from Post Office car park. Clerk to contact Cornwall Council to see if a solution, particularly if more people are to park there because of the issues existent with parking near club / terrace / bridge. Is it possible to put a new lamp in / move the existing one from the terrace, or is it possible for PC to mount a movement sensitive one in the car park.

16/086 Preparations for winter - . Sandbag deployment plan explained. More people to be sandbag fillers requested. Currently approximately 25 bags filled and (hopefully) strategically positioned at Netherton Lane and near Mrs L.White and Mrs J. Fisher (Leat Cottages)

Salt – agreed by all to buy the same amount of small bagged salt as last year. This is to be stored at suitable sites through the parish.

16/087 Neighbourhood Plan update. Working towards presenting draft plan to Cornwall Council officially for review and screening by official bodies in early 2017. Much work to do still.

16/088 Laptop guarantee – This expires shortly. Proposed to pay for 4 years further cover by Cllr.J Dennis, seconded by Cllr.H Price. Voted Not to do this by 5 votes to 2.

16/089 Funding for planters - agreed in principle. Need to finalise details at next meeting.

16/090 Planning – PA16/010021 The Old Rectory - No objections with this application.
